

ProHair™ Extension Care

Follow these simple guidelines to maintain your extension hairstyle and they will continue to look and feel natural for up to three months.

Brushing

Your new hairstyle should be brushed daily. Before brushing, apply a light mist of ProHair Daily Conditioning Spray that will maintain the condition of your hair and extensions. The protein-enriched formula contains sunscreens and pro-vitamins to protect and condition your natural hair. Only use a padded, soft bristle brush, never use a ball tip brush or comb as these can pull and damage your extensions. Ask your hairdresser to show you the correct brushing technique. Avoid pulling your extensions with the brush when they are warm.



Drying and Styling

Ask your hairdresser how to maintain your hairstyle. Allow your hair to air dry for the best results. When using a blow dryer, select a warm (not hot) setting and use a diffuser. If setting a blow dry style use the cold setting. Heated rollers work well and will provide a long holding curl if you allow them to cool completely before taking down. Use a curler one size smaller than the finished curl size you desire. Flocked, hot rollers will help protect the ends of your hair. Avoid using heated styling tools with a metal surface. You

may use any of your normal styling products with your extensions, (hairspray, mousse, gel, etc.)



Shampooing and Conditioning

Avoid wetting or washing your extensions for 2-3 days after initial application. Consult your hairdresser if your hair is prone to oiliness. ProHair Frequent Use Shampoo contains a formulation of special ingredients to cleanse the natural hair and your extensions without build-up. Rinse thoroughly around the extension seals. To retain the wave in your extensions, shampoo and rinse in cool water. After shampooing use Prohair Conditioning Rinse to keep your extensions manageable and lustrous. Apply a small amount evenly from mid-length to the ends, avoid applying conditioner around the extension seals. Rinse thoroughly in tepid water.



General Information

- Your new hairstyle will feel different but within a few days it will feel perfectly natural.
- Try to avoid twisting or playing with your hair as this may cause irritation or loosen the seals causing the extensions to come out.
- Your extensions may be worn for three months, during this time you may lose one or two, do not be concerned this is normal and will not affect your hairstyle. Your stylist will be pleased to maintain your extensions on your regular visits to the salon.
- Your extensions should be removed after approximately three months. Your stylist can remove them or show you how to correctly remove your extensions at home without damaging your natural hair.
